This weekend is September Crown! Come and support Your Kingdom, be there and see with your own eyes as those great warriors clash in honorable combat and vie to be your next King! Hood River is where it will all take place, an event you will not want to miss!

The next event for the Branch is Last Chance, which will be held at the Kitsap Saddle Club in Port Orchard on the 30th of September – the 2nd of October. Heavy Armored

In August, we had a few new and renewal authorizations signed and submitted to Kingdom. Our heavy armored practices are held on Tuesday evenings at the Silverdale VFW Hall on Central Valley Road. In order to optimize fighting time we start practices at 5:30 pm to allow some extra time to armor up. The building will not be available until the Social begins at 6:00 pm. We hold practice as long as we can manage the weather and light, or 8:00 pm, whichever comes first.

Rapier

Rapier practices continue at the VFW Hall on Tuesday evenings in conjunction with the Baronial Social. Come on out and practice. Loaner gear is available and all levels of experience are welcome.

Archery

Work continues on a catapult and a second and THIRD ballista with hopes that all will be in action soon. The catapult is probably closest to being next. There were some structural failures during testing that will be easily overcome with a simple redesign.

If you have an opportunity for additional practices you are strongly encouraged to take advantage of these. Please keep me informed so that I can include this information in my reports. Also, if you need or want the Barony to be more involved, don't hesitate to talk to me.

Chief Acher: Sunny weather has brought out many an archer. The new archer range has been full almost every practice. The Long range has seen nights of having to shoot 2 lines in order for us all to fit. The archery passes, for use of loaner gear, have been working wonderfully and the clipboard has at least 20 new archer forms on it, though I suspect more.

Autumn War and Archery Academy happened last month. Autumn War was hot and I had to miss it, so I will let someone else fill you all in on that. Archery Academy was a weekend of all things Missile. Many archers from all over attended. Baron Loric, your Archery Champion Sir Andras Truemark, Lord Thomas of Salisbury, and I attended. Loric and Andras spent Saturday teaching courses, Andras on the Archery Range for Speed Round Shooting and Equipment Tuning, Loric taught Missile and Target Marshalling. Thanks to Loric I will now be Missile Marshall Certified (combat archery).

We are entering my final month as Chief Archer. It has been a privilege to serve this Barony as your Archery MiC. I will step down at the end of Last Chance..

IKAC are done on the first Wednesday of the month.

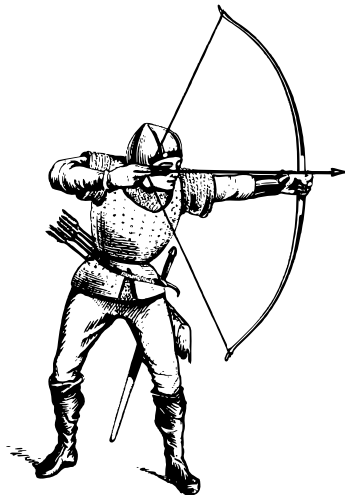
Parents who bring children to the range must watch them or bring another parent to watch them in order for the parent to participate in Archery. If you do not bring an adult to watch your children you do not get to shoot. NO exceptions.

If your children are also shooting there must be a parent present at the short range while the children are shooting.



Please do not cross any safety zone, or use the main gate, at anytime when the short range is set up. This includes if the line is closed for retrieving arrows. This is for your safety.

On nights when other groups are using the building please use the back door up the stairs to use the restrooms.

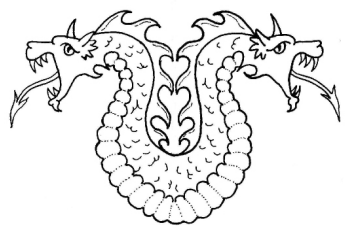

Hand Sewing Part 2 – Practice, Practice, Practice

This class takes what you learned at Countess Elizabeth's class on Sept 20 and gives you practice time. Countess Elisabeth, Dame Ellen, Dame Gwen and Magistra Aelianora will be on hand to help coach you through your beginning stitches. We will bring finished pieces of garb so you can see what the seams can look like.

Preparation for Arts and Sciences Competitions

Session 1, October 4: So You Want To Enter an A&S Competition?

Facilitated by Dame Gwen the Potter, Dragon's Laire A&S Champion

The first class in this series will be general information on how to prepare for an A&S Competition at Dragon's Laire baronial level. Information gained here can be translated into an entry at Kingdom. We will go over basic documentation, display, and presentation. Former Champions and Judges will be on hand to field questions.

Session 2, October 11: Research for A&S Entries

Facilitated by Magistra Aelianora de Wyntringham, Former Dragon's Laire A&S Champion and a current Dragon's Laire Scholar with help from other DL Scholars and Champions

Research is an integral part of preparation for an A&S competition in Dragon's Laire. Although research can seem intimidating, most will find it is exciting and interesting and much less intimidating than they expected when they get started. This class will discuss how to do basic research, the differences between a good resource and a questionable one, and provide some general resources for research. If you have started research, come to the class, we want to see what you've done and help you do more! If you've never done research, come to the class, we'll help you get started! And if you are an 'expert', head on over to the class, we want your help!

Session 3, October 18: A&S Competition Round Table

Facilitated by Dame Gwen the Potter, with assistance from various Baronial members who have entered or judged both at Baronial level and Kingdom level.

This session will be a round table discussion, encouraging those interested to ask questions from those who have been there as competitors or judges. The new Kingdom judging forms will be touched on (as they are being re-vamped),

and the Baronial judging criteria will be discussed. The panel will field questions, and offer advice and support for those interested in entering an A&S competition, whether they have never entered a competition before, or are experienced artisans who have entered.

Other positions as they make themselves known.

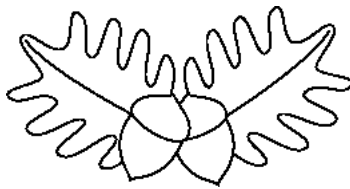

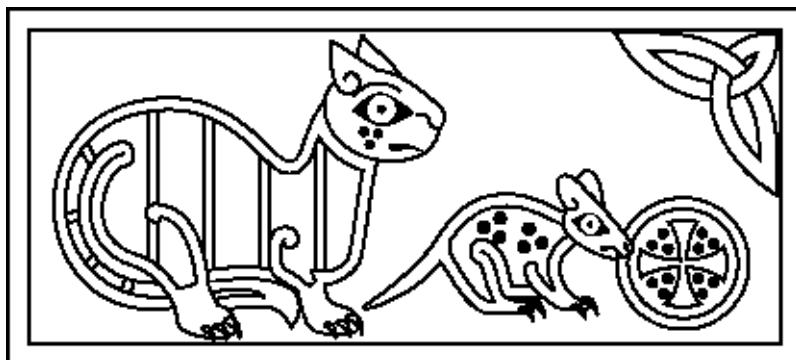
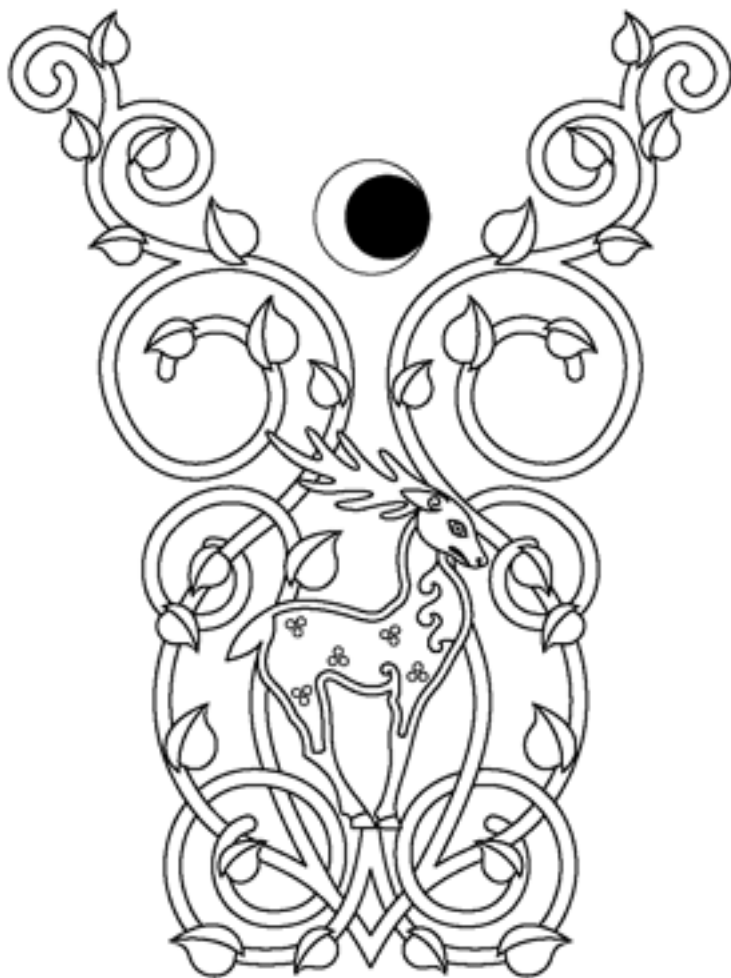
